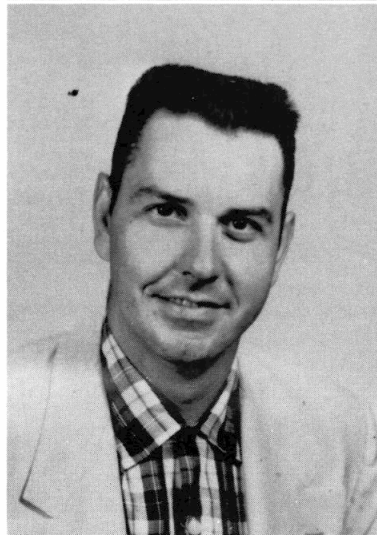
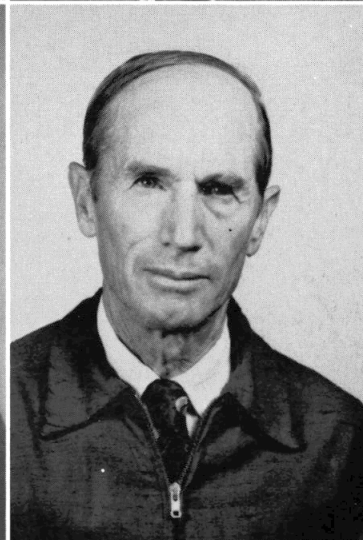
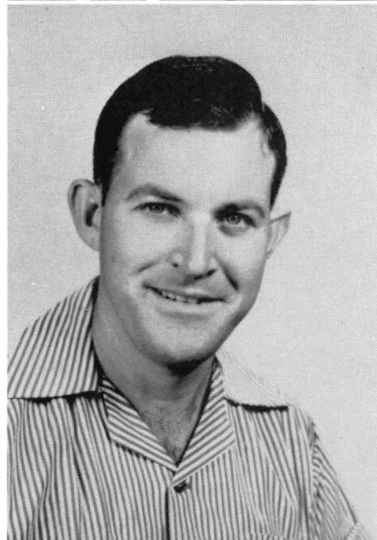
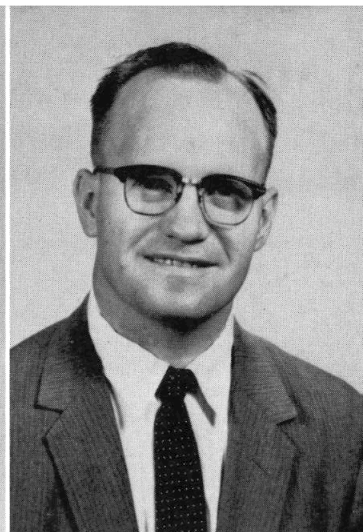
## PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

To those of you who are left--keep on making your school years "the best years."

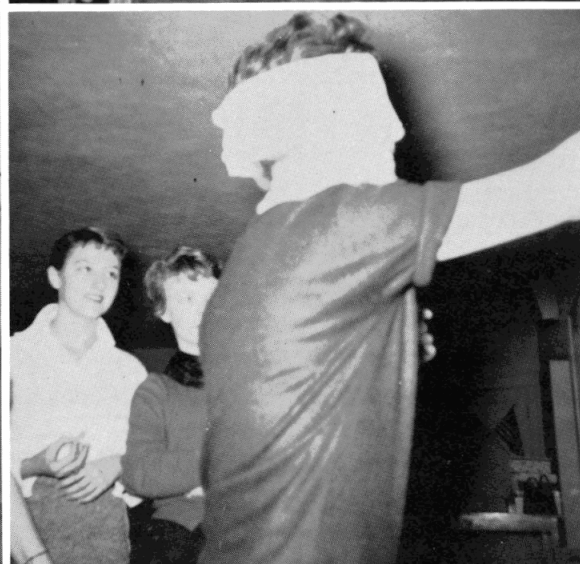
