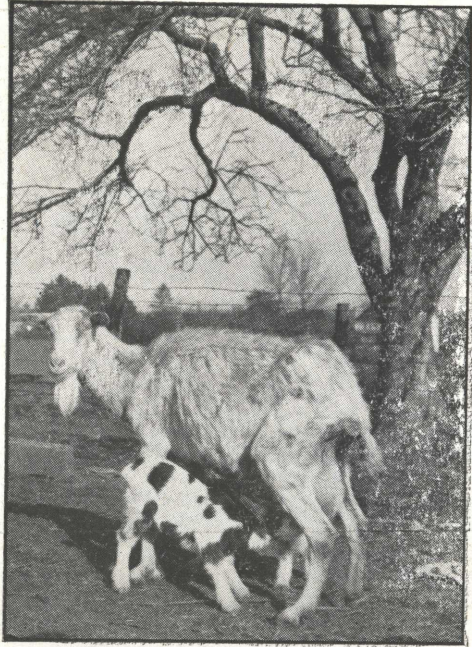

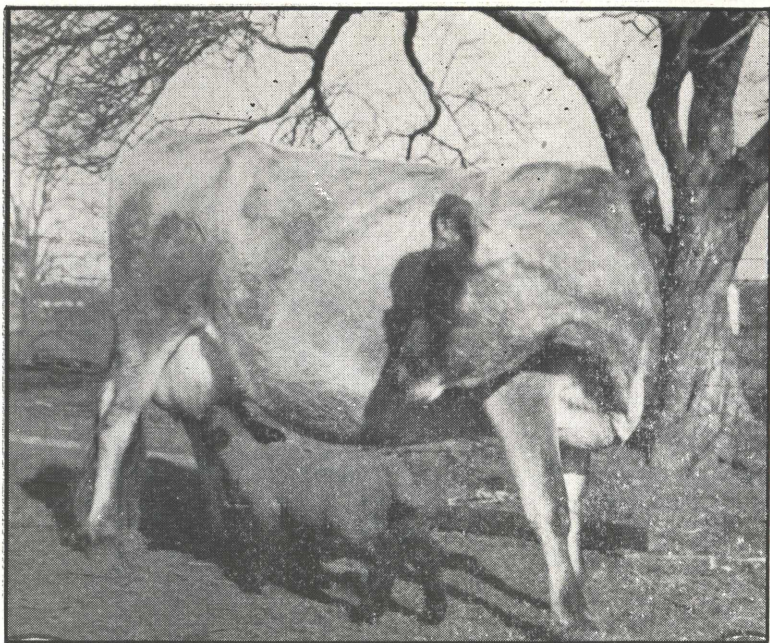
"WE'RE ABOUT READY TO MOVE"

The desired land will provide a future for much of the "young life" of this school.



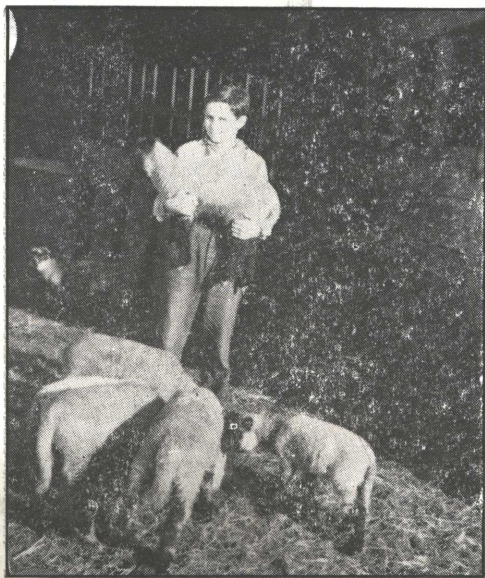
**Three Handsome Herefords

around?**

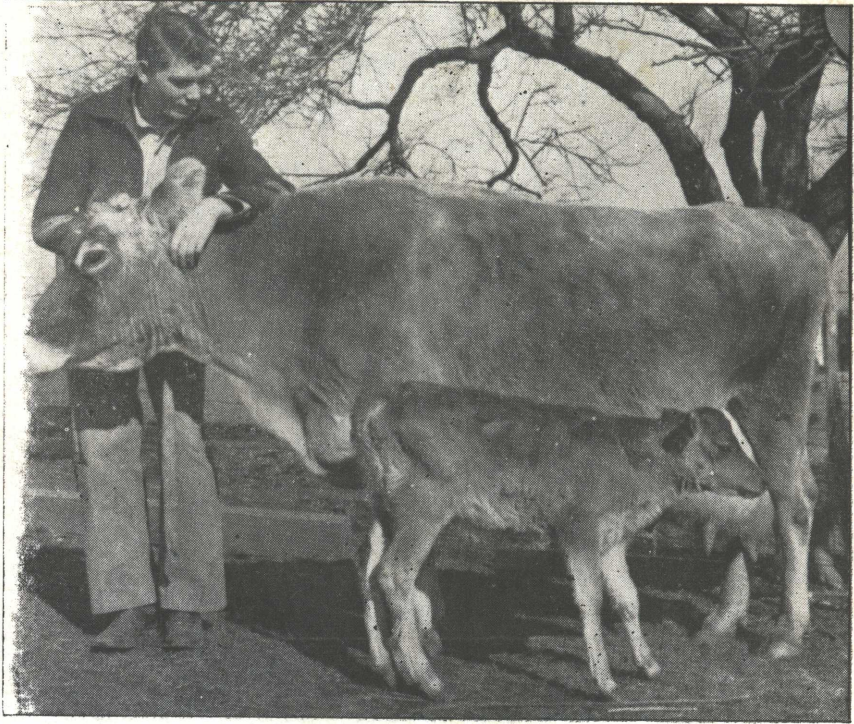


"SAY! DOESN'T YOUR MOTHER EVER FEED YOU?"
