BETA CLUB

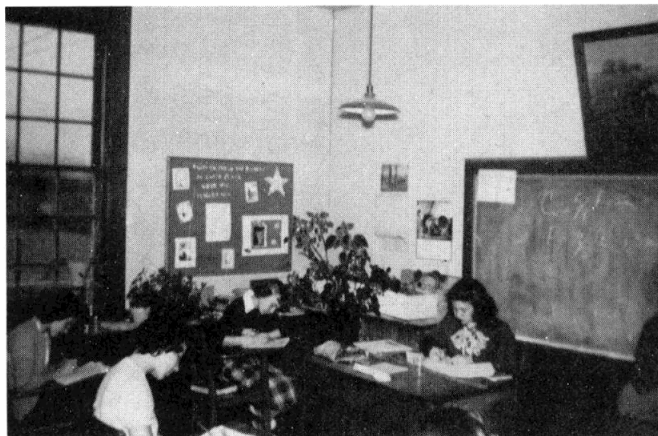


The Beta Club was organized in Pleasant Hill High School for the first time this year.

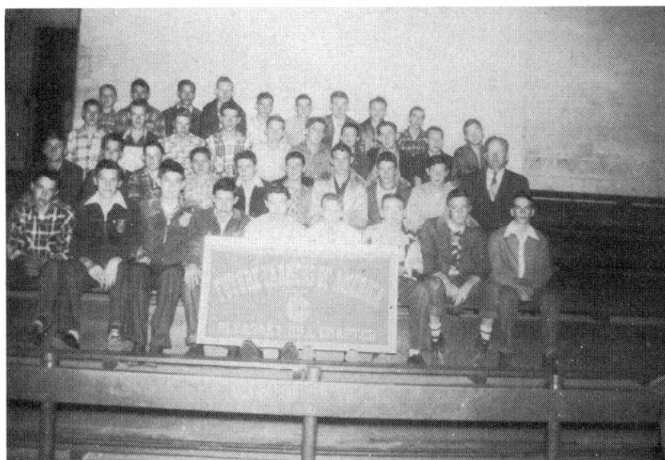
